The CARE-Ready Life Coaching® Model Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Listen, Lift, Launch II: Training and Certification in CARE-Ready Life Coaching® is the collaborative initiative of the STEP Forward Life InstituteTM, C & C Connections, LLC, Fruitful Life Network, Inc., iChange NationsTM, and United Graduate College and Seminary Int'l.

1. What does it mean to be CARE-Ready?

The idea of being CARE-ready came from the realization that not everyone in positions and roles to help people is actually READY to help people. They can even have the education, training and credentials to work in people-helping industries, but that doesn't always mean they have the instincts or the inner capacity to connect with them.

To be CARE-Ready or to possess CARE-Readiness means you are presenting a combination of high emotional intelligence, balanced mental healthiness, intellectual humility, and strong spiritual wellness in your personal and professional relationships.

The CARE-Ready person has a more responsive approach to "doing life" with people. Being CARE-Ready means that you have been enlightened to stop debating with or trying to correct people, to listening and trying to understand them and their life's journey.

2. How is THIS training different from other life coaching and mentoring programs?

Many coaching, mentoring and community outreach programs employ what is known as a "deficit model" of working with people; That's where you focus on the problems of a person, and then apply a set of pre-determined, one-size-fits-all, cookie cutter steps and treatments to address their issues. The deficit-based model is what many well-meaning providers use, but it rarely works long-term, leaving providers wondering why their clients fail to break the cycles of discouragement and defeat.

However, the CARE-Ready Life Coaching model mirrors the principles found in the proven, **Best Practice strategies of Strength-based, Solution-focused models**. Our Coaches are trained to connect with people in order to build a relationship/ partnership that empowers the client; thus allowing the client to discover the solutions that will work best for them. It's not about "assess and treat". Instead, it's about listening for understanding, and giving guidance as discoveries are made about one's life and goals.

Also, while many life coaching programs focus on teaching you how to target potential high-paying affluent clients, and high-paying speaking opportunities, we train, equip and empower you to become a Care-Ready Coach who is willing to take on the most often overlooked people of society; those who live in under-served communities, who can least afford, yet benefit the most from professional guidance.

3. Is this an accredited program?

This Program offers a **ministry-accredited** certification that has universal application. It is administered by the STEP Forward Life InstituteTM, which Chris and Carol Green founded as an affiliate of United Graduate College and Seminary International (UGCSI). UGCSI is a fully accredited member of the Accrediting Association of Bible Schools and Theological Institutions, Inc. Its primary mission is honoring and elevating those who, through life experience, proven ministry and authorship, are considered deserving of being recognized in a scholarly way.

4. How long does it take to complete the CARE-Ready Life Coach Certification Program?

This Program consists of recordings from actual training sessions; and it includes coursework assignments, a final project, and a final exam. The program instructors keep office hours available, exclusively for students who desire deeper conversation and explanation. A direct link for Zoom conference/ appointments is provided at the conclusion of each lesson. Students can work through the online courses at a pace that best fits their life, and have up to one year to complete the program.

5.) Will this certificate carry the credentials to be accepted anywhere?

There is no guarantee that all Coaching Certificates will be recognized and accepted everywhere. Our intent is to provide a Certificate that can be presented in tandem with the entire new Coach's other credentials. The CARE-Ready Life Coaching® Certification should be considered as part of your entire "body of work" ie. academic and honorary degrees, other certifications, awards, accomplishments and distinctions.

When you investigate the education and training of coaches, it can be confusing because there are so many coaching credentials. The ones that are recognized the most are the credentials issued by the International Coach Federation (ICF). The coaching industry has somewhere between 200 and 500 independent, for-profit coach training schools, and a small number of universities also offer coach training programs. Some of those certificates take years to acquire. Others can be earned during a weekend workshop.

Due to the wide range of coaching programs, a few different governing bodies have sprung up to (try to) establish a standard of education, training, and ethics among coaches. The three most commonly referenced governing bodies are:

- The International Coach Federation (ICF)
- The International Association of Coaching (IAC)
- The Center for Credentialing and Education (CCE)

Many faith-based institutions do not submit themselves under these governing bodies. However, they choose to adopt the same or similar standards. Chris and Carol Green adopted the standards of the American Association of Christian Counselors.

UGCSI's College of Divinity: Educational Department worked with the Greens to create THIS accelerated course, specifically for people working in human services and community outreach that covers months of material in 15 hours of instruction. This is because this program is primarily promoted toward students who already have a background and foundation embedded within them from their disciplines, academic study, and on-the-job experience. The CARE-Ready Coach certification is not necessarily a program for the general public.

Chris and Carol Green strongly urge students who have little or no prior experience or instruction in human service or community outreach, to first enroll in their CARE-Ready Responder training.


CARE-Ready Responder Training will help you:

Evidence-Based and Best Practice Principles

The CARE-Ready Life Coach Training is grounded in evidence-based principles and Best Practices of instruction. We employ the **Participatory Approach to Training**.

Our training is not data and knowledge driven. You will be asked to do more than memorize concepts and then take an exam. Instead, you will become an active participant in your training. You will not be initially asked to become the Life Coach, but you will take on the role as the client (the person who is being coached).

The Learning Pyramid

Studies show that varying your study methods and materials will improve your retention and recall of information, and enhance your learning experience. The "learning pyramid", sometimes referred to as the "cone of learning", developed by the National Training Laboratory, suggests that most students only remember about 10% of what they read from textbooks, but retain nearly 75% of what they learn by practicing.
